Bank of America Web site goes down

Bank of America's Web site went down on Friday, leaving many customers angry after being unable to conduct online banking on the first day of the month, according to [USAToday](#).

The banking giant issued a statement saying it was working closely with customers to help alleviate any concerns they might have, the paper reported.

While no reason was given for the online outage, the New York Times reported that a cyber hack attack was not suspected.

Hacking was to blame for a series of widespread Web site outages among many big banks in recent months. Both **Fifth Third Bancorp** and PNC Financial Services Group were hit with suspected cyber attacks in January, both of which hit Dayton-area customers as those are two of the largest banks in the local market.

In late September, a series of cyber attacks blamed on Iran hit big banks such as BofA, JPMorgan Chase, Citigroup, Wells Fargo and **U.S. Bancorp**.
